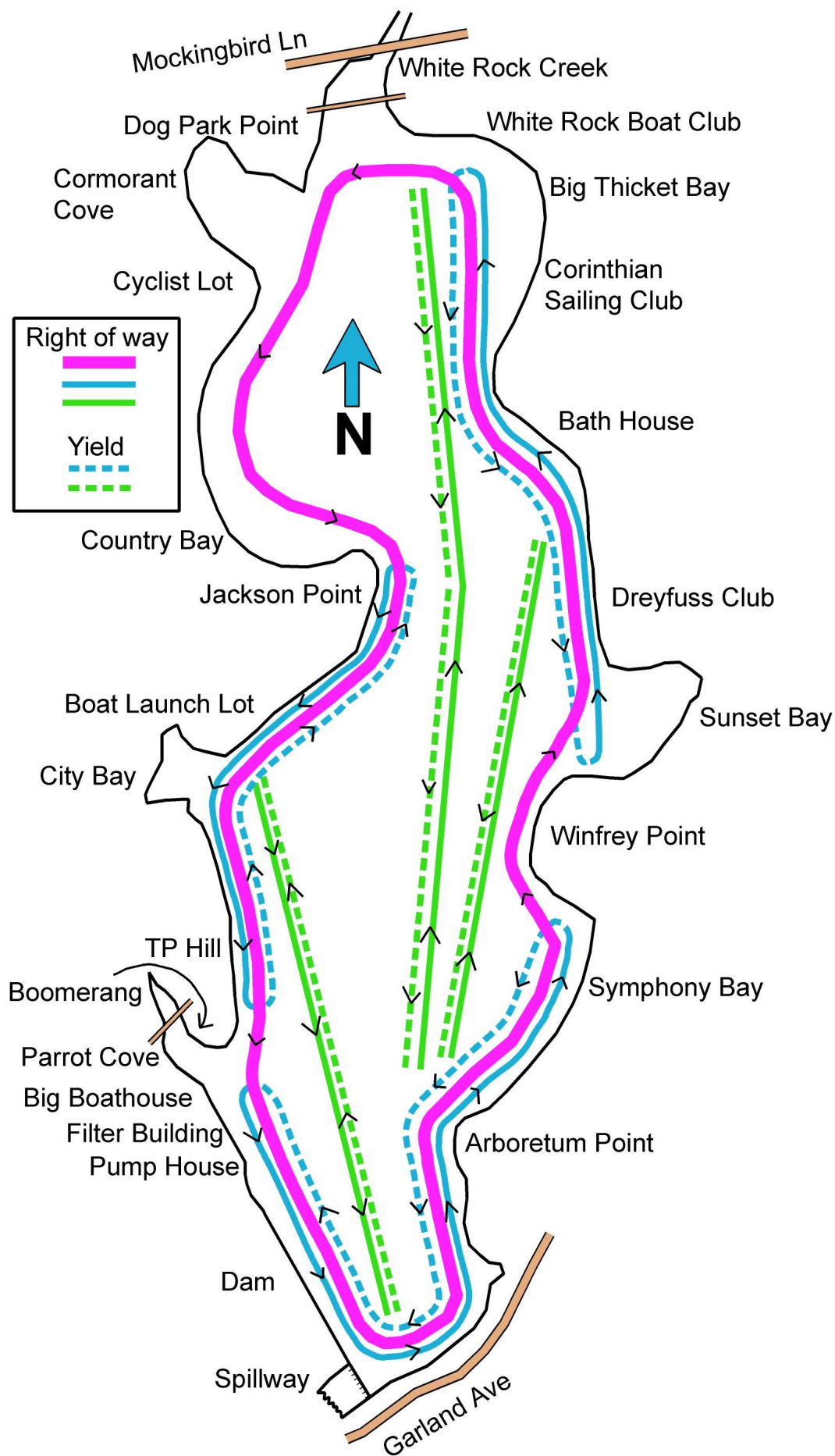


White Rock Lake



Summary of navigation rules:

(For details see the document "Policies and Rules for White Rock Boathouse.")

1. The default rowing pattern is counter-clockwise.
2. Overtaking boats have right of way over slower boats.
3. Row on the paddle with increased awareness inside the buoyed area in front of the Boomerang and BBH docks.
4. Coaches in launches are expected to maintain close proximity to their crew's boats and should keep groups of boats together.
5. Traffic and weather conditions sometimes dictate deviations from the default rowing pattern. Alternative rowing patterns may be used depending on weather conditions:
 - a) The parallel racing lanes.
 - b) South wind laps.
 - c) East wind laps.
 - d) North wind laps.
6. Row with a "defensive rowing" attitude at all times. Possession of right-of-way should not be held in an aggressive manner nor should it lead to unsafe rowing encounters.
7. Any rower or crew deviating from the default rowing pattern of counter-clockwise, even those acknowledged above, in any condition, loses right of way to those following the default rowing pattern.
